

# PRAYER POINTS



## November

- 1** Give thanks to God for all those who came to faith during the Durban Mission in October.
- 2** Pray that God would bring peace amidst political unrest in Zimbabwe.
- 3** Pray for the CTG (Community Transformational Groups) Programme in Ghana. Pray that the community would be transformed by engaging in this programme.
- 4** Pray that in majority-Muslim countries, the good news of the gospel would cut through and bring true confidence to people.
- 5** Pray for the Church in Nigeria, especially in the north, where believers are persecuted.
- 6** Pray for provision and hope for widows, orphans and other victims of the Rwandan genocide. Even after many years, the impacts are still strongly felt.
- 7** Pray for the expansion of youth ministry in Congo. Pray that many young people will be reached with the gospel.
- 8** Pray for the finances of African Enterprise. Pray that God would provide the finances and resources required for all activities, including missions, social action projects and training of ministers.
- 9** Pray for all AE Team Leaders, that God would give them added strength as they arrange plans for Missions for 2024.
- 10** Pray for International CEO Dr Stephen Mbogo, for God's wisdom and guidance as he gives leadership to the Partnership.
- 11** Pray for the safe removal of millions of landmines in Angola, which are killing many, especially children.
- 12** Pray that new believers who started following Jesus during AE missions would be quickly integrated into Bible-believing churches where they can be disciplined and encouraged.

- 13** Pray for the new government in Burkina Faso. Pray that the new government will uphold religious freedom.
- 14** Pray that God would reveal himself to the nomadic desert tribes in Morocco.
- 15** Pray for more international partners to come and support AE mission teams and share in the joy of God at work in Africa.
- 16** Pray for the protection of the Christians in Libya as they share their faith.
- 17** Pray for the support offices of AE – in Australia, New Zealand, the USA, Canada, Hong Kong, Europe and Ireland. Pray that we would offer excellent support, sufficient finances and wise counsel to the teams in Africa.
- 18** Pray for South Africa and the elections in 2024. Pray that God would appoint a godly government to lead the country.
- 19** Thank God for the supporters of African Enterprise who give so generously to make this ministry possible.
- 20** Pray that God would end the exploitation of children in Cote d'Ivoire, where many are forced into harvesting coffee and cocoa beans.
- 21** Pray that the Egyptian church will grow in strength to impact the wider region with the gospel.
- 22** Pray for unity among pastors and leaders as they prepare for missions. Pray for peaceful discussions, prayerful consultation and unity of purpose and passion.
- 23** Pray for Australian CEO Simba Musvamhiri as he visits churches to encourage partnership with AE. Pray that God would give him clarity in his communications as he speaks about the work of AE.
- 24** Pray that God would continue to bless the women's sewing project in Ethiopia, offering opportunities for women to be trained in a skill that can provide an income for their families.
- 25** Pray that the Pastors Training Course will equip many more pastors in 2024 and uplift the body of Christ across Africa.
- 26** Thank God for the Lilongwe mission in Malawi in October, and pray that those who turned to Christ would stand firm in their new faith.
- 27** Pray that the Soweto Kayole Clinic in Kenya is well-provisioned with medical supplies and nursing staff to serve the community's vulnerable.
- 28** As COVID-19 continues to affect Africa, pray for health and safety, and for effective prevention and treatment of disease.
- 29** Pray for God to continue to bring reconciliation between the different ethnic groups in South Sudan.
- 30** Thank God for giving us prayer as a way to speak with Him. Ask that He would help you devote yourself to prayer even more as you see Him answer your requests.
