13 Missions to be held for 2023. Please pray that God's will, will be done.



# May 2023

- 01** The Easter missions held in partnership with the Bible Society have just finished in Rwanda and Kenya. Pray new believers will stay strong in faith.
- 02** For all the Social Action Projects proposals received this year, that we may be able to fund and pray together along with all our AE supporters and partners and for the all national Team staff on the ground delivering on the projects to help transform lives.
- 03** Pray for the AE Rwanda team as they prepare to proclaim in Kigali during 11-18 June.
- 04** Pray for Kenya's Mathare Women Project. AE Kenya is pursuing a partnership with a Church in Mathare to relocate the project, provide extra space to reach more women in need, and reduce rent costs.
- 05** Thank God for the success of the Togo SCAP program, where youth are rescued from the challenges of unemployment and then empowered economically.
- 06** Praise God for the wonderful work done in the South Sudan Trauma Healing Program. The program has been expanded this year to 10 more schools, reaching out to 30 schools with over 12,000 beneficiaries.
- 07** AE Tanzania will have their citywide mission in Dar-es-Salaam from 16-23 August. Pray for the team as they prepare for the mission.
- 08** Keep in your prayers the Ngezandla Zethu Women Project in South Africa that equips women with skills in dress-making and fashion design. Pray for God's hand upon the project this year.
- 09** Pray for the Kenya mission that will take place in Nairobi from 7-17 September. Pray that the team will have the necessary wisdom and preparation for sharing the Gospel.
- 10** Pray that the Pastors Training Course will equip many more pastors this year and uplift the Body of Christ across Africa.
- 11** Pray for the preparation of the AE Uganda team as they get ready for the Fort Portal Mission from 15-24 September.
- 12** Pray that the Word of God will take root in the hearts of school children in Ethiopia as they attend the Students' Discipling Program.
- 13** AE South Africa will have a citywide mission in Durban from 8-17 September. Pray for the team and Foxfires as they prepare for mission.
- 14** Pray for the Ethiopia Women's Sewing Program to be conducted in 2023 to help many vulnerable women in need.
- 15** Pray for the AE Malawi team as they get everything in place for the citywide mission in Lilongwe from 21-29 October.
- 16** Today is the **International Day of Living Together in Peace**.
- 17** DRC will have a Leadership mission in Moanda from 7-14 October. Pray for the team and all the preparations that need to be done.
- 18** Please pray for a new project proposal in South Africa – The Nyawonhle Shoe Repair Training Project. It intends to target the economic empowerment of unemployed men.
- 19** Pray for the wisdom, safety and God's grace over the AE Zimbabwe team as the Mutare Citywide Mission starts today.
- 20** Pray for the Youth Economic Empowerment Project in Tanzania. The program teaches tailoring, computer skills, business ideas creation, and bookkeeping basics to 100 youths over two years.
- 21** Pray for peace and reconciliation in Africa and for God to continue to use AE in this regard.
- 22** Pray for the Woman Empowering Sewing Skills Training Program in Malawi so the team can equip even more women in the 2023 program.
- 23** Zambia will have their Citywide Mission in Kabwe this year. Please pray that God will bless this mission that will take place from 3-10 November.
- 24** Pray for Rwanda, where a Market Sanitation program has been proposed to support the National Sanitation Program Policy.
- 25** Pray for the Soweto Kayole Clinic plans for a new maternity wing to provide prenatal and postnatal care for the local community.
- 26** Ghana projects investment in Bakery training, Aluminum Fabrication, women' Sewing, and Computer training through the Ghana SCAP programs.
- 27** The last mission of the year will be in Bole. Please pray for the AE Ethiopia team that will start this Citywide mission on the 18th of December.
- 28** Pray that the Soweto Kayole Clinic in Kenya is well-provisioned with medical supplies and nursing staff to serve the community's vulnerable.
- 29** Pray that the hearts of supporters will be opened to help more people in Africa to be uplifted by AE's work.
- 30** Thank God for our Women's Empowerment projects in South Africa, Kenya, Malawi and Ghana. Pray for the expansion of these projects to equip even more women to provide for their families.
- 31** Pray that hearts will be open to the Gospel during the mission weeks!

## Spotlight on Uganda

Uganda's population is rapidly growing, with the median age being only 16. Our mission work aims to bring Christ to a nation that is suffering from corruption and deprivation.



## June 2023

- 01 Pray that the Citywide Mission on 15-24 September will be a success, seeing many people accepting God as their Savior. The target population is 80,000 people.
- 02 Pray for the vision casting and training of 150 pastors.
- 03 The Uganda office needs 300 evangelists for the mission; please pray that God will send the right people to help spread His Word.
- 04 Pray that funds will be received in time, as it costs UGX 500,000 to sustain an evangelist for ten days, including transport, accommodation and meals.
- 05 **International World Environment Day:** In Isaiah 43 and 66, God promise that our peace will flow like rivers in the desert. Pray that all people will see the world through God's eyes and correspond with His plan for peace, fullness and beauty as He desired when He created it.
- 06 Pray for the mobile rallies around the city and open-air evangelism trucks that have started to make people aware of what is coming.
- 07 Pray that God will reach the leaders of the city when stratified ministry starts in the next few months, including the Political leaders' dinner, Business leaders' meeting, Church leaders fellowship and Professionals meetings.
- 08 Pray that the radio ministry during the mission period will be fruitful.
- 09 Pray for the team during the city cleaning period that the example will be set, the right questions be asked, and evangelising already starts.
- 10 We need unity in the Uganda churches. Let us pray for unity to be restored with the help of our AE Uganda team.
- 11 Pray with AE Uganda to have a concrete partnership with TV owners for ministry, as this is an ongoing process. So far, we have airtime on Family TV, a Church of Uganda-owned television, and negotiations have started with UBC, a government-owned television network.
- 12 Pray for AE Uganda's school ministry and the opportunity given to the team in University Chaplaincies to preach the Gospel during lunch hour fellowships.
- 13 Pray that Christian teachers and students will have the passion to share the Gospel with fellow teachers and students, and also to follow up on the new converts in their schools.
- 14 Pray that the churches will implement Home-based Evangelism (HBE) through the home cell approach.
- 15 Pray that the trained pastors, Youth Leaders, and Evangelists will reproduce themselves among other church members and influence them with the message from the Bible.
- 16 Pray for the effective implementation of Gospel campaign activities in schools and universities. The team will target churches, Evangelistic organisations and the Government of Uganda through the ministry of Education.
- 17 The target to reach people through mass media, TV, and radio programs are 700,000 people. Pray that through the grace of God, the team will succeed in doing so and that many will tune in for mass media evangelism.
- 18 Pray that the AE Uganda team shall consolidate and initiate strong partnerships that shall carry out the preservation of believers as they do ministry.
- 19 Pray that the church and youth leaders will ensure that the new believers are in churches and growing in Christ.
- 20 Pray that the old and newly trained pastors and evangelists shall be the catalyst of Evangelism and Discipleship in the church in Uganda.
- 21 Pray the Safe Resilient Adolescents and Youth Project (SRAY) get the support and funding for a successful project implementation.
- 22 Pray that there will be much enthusiasm, increased awareness, and engagement in youth groups to join the Community Transformation Groups (CTGs) to develop income generating activities and employments skills.
- 23 Pray that after (SRAY), there's an improved capacity of local leaders to support their congregations to engage in addressing community challenges and support livelihood activities.
- 24 As a result of (SRAY), pray that there will be increased access to reproductive healthcare services among the youth.
- 25 Pray for the "Community Transformation Groups", that the beneficiaries will experience holistic transformation in both economic and social aspects.
- 26 Pray that project beneficiaries for the CTG groups will be willing to change their mindset and eventually become agents of transformation in the community.
- 27 Pray for the health and well-being of staff and patients at The Milne Medical Clinic. The clinic was started by AE supporters in Australia, providing free support for the local community and focusing on expecting and new mothers.
- 28 Pray for funding and supporting partners of Nile Vocational Institute in Jinja and for all the youth enrolled in the training programs.
- 29 Continue to pray for reconciliation amongst ethnic groups in Uganda.
- 30 Pray for the AE Uganda Director, Beson Baguma and his team that they will persevere and be effective instruments for God.

## Spotlight on Malawi

The Citywide Mission in Lilongwe will take place from 21-29 October. Let us pray that God's power will be at work.



## July 2023

- 01** Pray for AE Malawi Director, Cornelius Huwa, and his lovely team that God will give them strength to spread the Word and protection from evil.
- 02** Pray that God will give wisdom in the formation of various Mission committees for the mission's success.
- 03** Pray with us for the churches' involved spirit of ownership and commitment towards the mission.
- 04** Pray for the church's love and passion towards the lost souls that need to be evangelised.
- 05** Pray for the local churches to be able to mobilise their church members for training as missionaries.
- 06** Pray for the Holy Spirit to equip the missionaries with various gifts like counselling, teaching, ushering and evangelism capabilities.
- 07** Pray for the availability of resources for the training to be conducted by the local missionaries.
- 08** Pray for the Holy Spirit to guide in the selection of dedicated individuals to be equipped with preservation skills in their respective churches in which they will facilitate the new converts.
- 09** Pray for resource availability towards the work of equipping the Preservation Facilitators.

- 12** Pray for the willingness and dedication of the Preservation Facilitators.
- 13** Pray for the power of the Holy Spirit to minister through these churches as they reach out to the communities.
- 14** Pray against the opposing spirits that harden the people's hearts from accepting the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 15** Pray for the transformative prayer meetings with leaders of various private and public institutions during proclamation week.
- 16** Pray for greater harvests of souls by the end of the proclamation week.
- 17** Pray for protection from spiritual attacks upon the missionaries during that period.
- 18** Pray for the Holy Spirit to strengthen those who will give their lives to Christ Jesus as their Saviour and Lord to strengthen or encourage their faith.
- 19** Pray the churches have the zeal and haste to nurture the new believers in Christ Jesus.
- 20** Praise God for the supporters/donors who contribute their wealth towards the "Woman Empowerment Sewing Skills Training Program" in Malawi. We are truly thankful.
- 21** Praise God for women who had undergone the tailoring training and are now running their tailoring businesses, which are helping them to transform their lives.
