

Rwanda Mission Report

Kayonza Mission for Jesus: 15-22 August 2021

8270 reached with the gospel, 1468 people who gave their hearts to Christ (excluding those who made decisions during mission preparation or through radio and media broadcasts).



AEE missionaries on the mission field preached the word and the 7 repented from their sins.

In partnership with local evangelical churches, AEE Rwanda carried out the Kayonza Mission for Jesus in Kayonza City of the Eastern Province in Rwanda.

The city was selected strategically because of the gaps in church leadership and agnostic beliefs.

Kayonza is the pathway to 6 out of the 7 districts of the Eastern Province and is at the intersection route to Uganda and Tanzania. This gave it a unique advantage to spread the Gospel beyond its boundaries.

The objective of the mission was to reinforce a passionate response to the Great Commission within the local church leaders. Through this mission the church leaders were empowered in both stratified evangelism and Home-Based Evangelism, (HBE).

AEE Rwanda introduced, equipped and applied HBE in Kayonza City through this mission. They also ushered the spiritual transformation through the Gospel of Jesus and provided sustainable tools for subsequent evangelistic missions among the partner churches.



A direct impact was made in the whole of the Eastern Province with both immediate harvest of lost souls and long-term harvest through empowered church partners.

The Kayonza Mission for Jesus focused on households, marketplaces, bus parks, prostitution zones, areas with more street children and drug users, universities and schools as well as prisons.



AEE also conducted evangelism in primary early child development centers (ECD)
